We will be playing the tournament at the High School and Elementary Gym.

After the pool games have taken place, the teams will be seeded into two 5 team double elimination tournaments. The Championship Bracket will be at the High School and the Consolation Bracket will be played at the Elementary School.

#### POOL PLAY RULES: (Day One)

- Games are best of 3, cap at 25 and 11
- 1-hour running clock. If time runs out, the team ahead wins. If tied, the next point wins. If time runs out and the third game is needed, the 3rd game will be played to 5 points.
- Warmup time is given only if time is available for warmups.
- Each team has two 30 second timeouts per game. No timeouts can be taken in the last two minutes of a game.
  - o Clock will continue to run during a timeout.
- First team listed is the home team
- Home team provides the official book. The book person needs to sit at the scorers' table. Home
- Warmups for these games will take place time permitting. Each team will have 3 minutes on the court to warm up.

## Tournament Seeding

- Teams will be placed in two 5 team double elimination tournaments on Saturday.
- Seeding will be determined after pool play.
- Tournament seeding will be determined as follows- 1. overall record 2. Head to Head 3. points scored against 4. coin toss.

## TOURNAMENT RULES: (Day Two) October 9, 2021

- Regular season JV games except capped at 25 in first two games and 11 in the third game. Championship game(s) and Consolation(s) are not capped.
- No running clock
- Each team has two 30 second timeouts per game.
- The home team is the higher seed. They will be expected to have their score keeper sit at the scorers table and to keep the official book.

**ADMISSION: \$6 per day or \$10 for a 2-day tournament pass**

### **Championship Plaques**

The winner of the tournament, the runner up and the winner of the consolation bracket will all receive a team plaque for their accomplishments.

### **Hospitality Room**

There will be a small hospitality room at each campus. This room is for coaches, bus drivers, and tournament personnel only. We hope that you enjoy the food and items that are provided. You will be provided wristbands for these individuals to wear so that they can enter into the hospitality room.

### **Concessions**
